SONGWRITER GROUPS DEMAND TRANSPARENCY IN MUSIC-AI DEALS

Music Creators North America (MCNA), alongside several other songwriter and creator organisations, has issued a unified call for full transparency and creator consent in all deals being struck between music companies and artificial intelligence developers. Their message centres on the need for writers to understand how their work is being ingested into AI training models, how AI-

generated music may use their material, how they'll be compensated, and how attribution will be protected. The statement follows a surge in licensing agreements between major music companies and Al firms, where catalogues, datasets and models are being commercialised. Creators argue these agreements are often opaque and leave rights-holders in the dark about future usage, financial participation and copyright safeguards. Industry observers note that the way Al-derived income is handled will become a key negotiation point in rights deals, influencing catalogue valuations, carve-outs and headline multiples. While Al offers potential new revenue streams, creator groups warn it also presents significant legal and ethical risks if transparency and consent are not front and centre.



POINT CLASSICS KEEPS KILLING IT: 7 CLASSICAL TRACKS PLACED IN 'DEXTER: RESURRECTION'

The new agreement gives One Media the exclusive rights to distribute and monetise the podcasts globally across streaming and digital platforms, covering artist-focused specials, historic retrospectives (*"Time Capsule"*, *"Year in Rock"*), storytelling formats (*"Classic Tales"*, *"Stories Behind the Songs"*), award and event programmes (*"Classic Rock Awards"*), and themed collections such as Power Ballads, Southern Rock, Stadium Rockers, Rock's Acoustic Side and The Great Anthems of Rock.
